0 : No local authorities currently at this level.	Hospitality businesses will be open during their normal licensing hours, both indoors and outdoors subject to socialising rules.
1 : Highland, Orkney, Shetland, Moray, Western Isles.	Indoors and outdoors: Last entry 9.30 pm. Must close 10.30 pm. Exemptions expected for the hotel residents.

<p>2: Aberdeenshire, Aberdeen City, Fife, Dumfries and Galloway, Perth and Kinross, Angus, Scottish Borders, Argyll and Bute.</p>	<p>Indoors: Last entry 7 pm. Must close 8 pm. Outdoors: Last entry 9.30. Must close 10.30 pm. Alcohol may only be supplied with a main meal. Exemptions expected for the hotel residents.</p>
<p>3: Inverclyde, East Dunbartonshire, West Dunbartonshire, Dundee, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire, Glasgow, South Ayrshire, East Ayrshire, North Ayrshire, Stirling, Edinburgh, Midlothian, West Lothian, East Lothian, Clackmannanshire, North Lanarkshire and South Lanarkshire.</p>	<p>No alcohol sales indoors or outdoors. Indoors and outdoors: Last entry 5 pm. Must close 6 pm. Exemptions expected for the hotel residents.</p>
